





COLTSVILLE RECONNECTED TO THE RIVER






NEW RIVERFRONT PARK AND BOULEVARD WITH I-91 BELOW






CONNECTICUT RIVER AS THE FOCUS BETWEEN HARTFORD AND EAST HARTFORD








