




Lowered Highway – Interchange Options




Western Interchange Option W3-3




Eastern Interchange Option 3B-E3(S)



Eastern Interchange Option 3B-E5(S)




Eastern Interchange Option 3B-E6(S)





Multimodal Station Study Area




Hartford Multimodal Station Planning and Design

- Kicked off in January 2017
- 12 month effort
 - Define program
 - Develop site layout alternatives
 - Identify preferred site layout
 - Prepare conceptual design plans (15%)

What We Heard From Stakeholders


- Seamless bus-rail connection allowing modes to "feed" off each other
- Station as a main regional transit center
- Station as gateway to Bushnell Park/downtown
- Strong bike/pedestrian connectivity
- Support future viability of Union Station
- Promote mixed use developments / TOD
- Easy transit vehicle access
- Structured/shared parking
- Anticipate future station needs; don't under build








Concept E Phase 1



Concept E Phase 2 Level 1



- Public Hearing, Spring of 2019
- Final EIS, Late 2019









Purpose of Survey

- How will I-84 travelers respond during construction?
 - Shift time of trip to avoid peak period congestion
 - Use alternate route
 - Change trip destination
 - Change mode to transit
 - Reduce or eliminate trip



How will information be used?

 In "Travel Demand Model" to predict travelers' responses during construction

In person intercepts: 476


Through businesses: 1,520




Study Area

Primary Trip Purpose



Factors that would change mode to transit



- Severe traffic delays
- Transit service improvements
 - Decreased cost
 - Increased frequency
 - More convenient
- Hartford parking difficulties
 - Reduced availability
 - Increased cost





PROJECT UPDATES

The I-84 Hartford Project Team has been working with communities to identify the best solution for fixing I-84. After exploring four different alternatives, or options, we're close to deciding on the future of the highway. A formal decision is expected in early 2019.

- 306 Respondents
- April-May 2017
- Establish baselines for success
- Identify best practices
- Understand public impressions of the PI process



Public Outreach Questionnaire

- What did we learn?
 - Preference for info via media, E-bulletins, website, public meetings
 - 60% had sufficient opportunity to provide feedback
 - 35% haven't provided feedback
 - ²/₃ say they better understand the project, ¹/₃ see consensus
- How are we responding?
 - Reporting back
 - Revising outreach activities to reach more communities
